This Morning's Music: César Franck was considered the greatest organ composer of the French school of the nineteenth century. He was the organist at Ste. Clotilde in Paris, and composed with the Cavaille-Coll organ there in mind. Musicians are often able to trace their heritage back to a particular teacher or school of training. My musical lineage is direct from Franck. César Franck taught Charles Tournemire, who taught Jean Langlais, who taught Ann Labounsky, who was my teacher. It is an honor, again this morning, to share the *Pièce Héroïque*, a triumphal composition, as we remember the triumphal entry of Christ into Jerusalem.
