GUIDELINES:

Participating vehicles should arrive on-site no later than 2:00 p.m. Entrance TBD. All participating trunks must be decorated and staffed by 2:30pm p.m. Vehicles arriving after 3:00 p.m. will not be allowed to participate for safety reasons. Trunk-or-treating begins at 3:00 p.m. To ensure safety, participating vehicles must remain parked until the event ends and the participants have vacated the area (by approximately 5:30pm.)

We ask for non-ghoulish decorations and costumes. Please refrain from any major gory items. There are many ideas for trunk decorations online. Some ideas include:
