Ingomar Living Water Christmas Project Miracle(s)!

This past Christmas, the people of Ingomar Church donated \$15,000 to enable Ingomar Living Waters (ILW) to fund the drilling of a well in Mepe, Ghana where flooding eradicated access to clean water.



Three wells for the price of one! RC Junior High School, Kedzikope Village, and Open Heaven in Mepe, Ghana now have access to clean water.

Remote water drilling projects are often fraught with obstacles and hardships, but to everyone's amazement, this project experienced a series of "miracles." It was expected that a very expensive filtration system would be needed to remove high salt content usually found near Mepe. However upon drilling the well, the rig hit CLEAN water ... no salts! So the costly filtration system was unnecessary and the cost of the project was \$5,000.

ILW's partner asked if they could apply the remainder of the funds to drill a second well at Kedzikope Village, and the request was granted. Again, they hit CLEAN water! So they identified a third location at Open Heaven, near Mepe and again hit CLEAN water. This is truly amazing!

We were expecting one well for \$15,000, but have been blessed with three

clean water wells that will serve 6,500 people (3,000 more that we had anticipated). We are so grateful for the generosity of Ingomar Church and for the unexpected blessings of water that is free of salt contaminates. Thanks be to God! 
